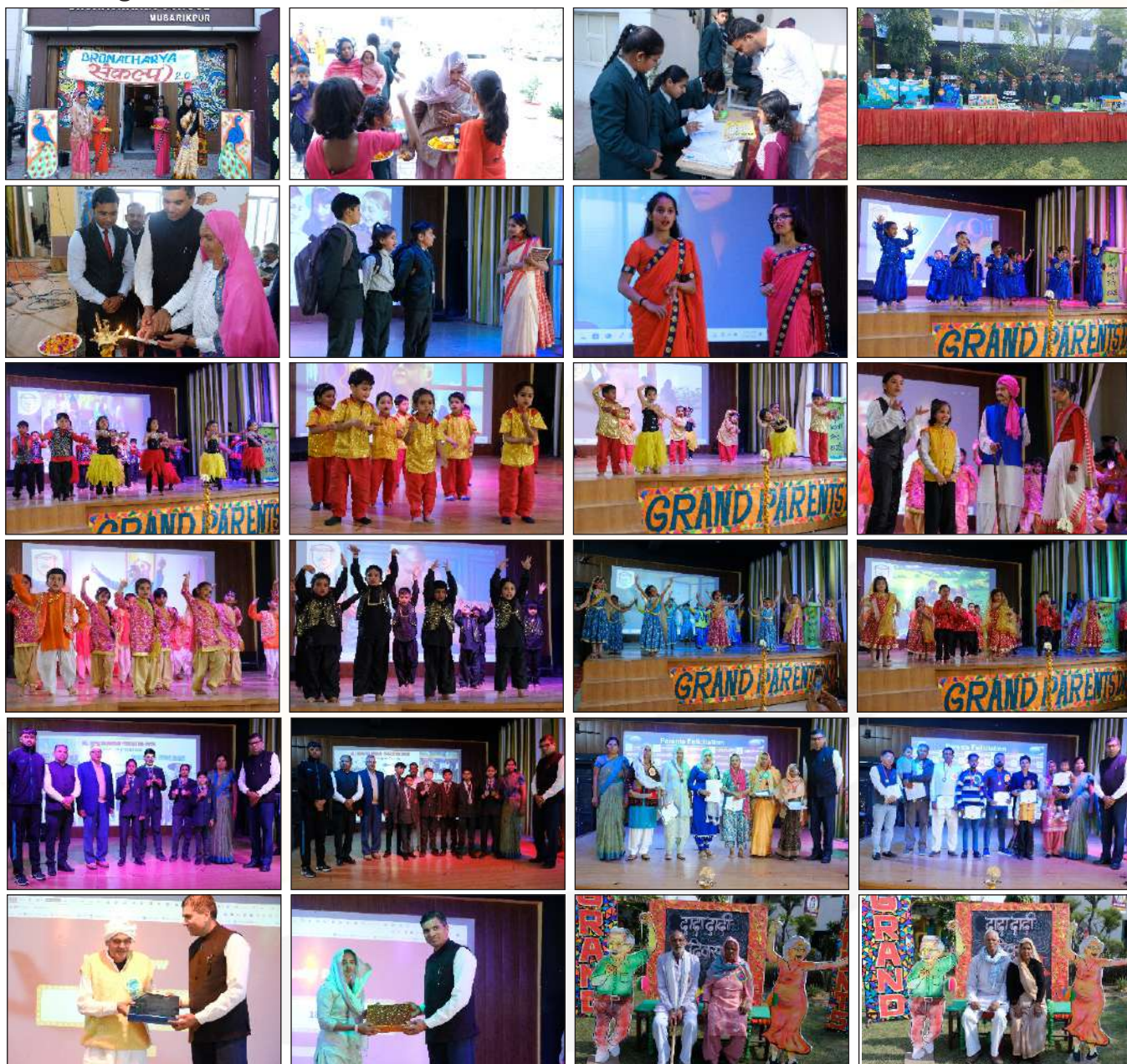
## GRANDPARENTS' DAY - DADA DADI KI MEHFIL

## Mrs. Manisha

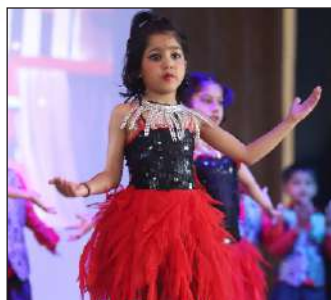
