- Make 2 square and 2 rectangles with help of compass and protractor

### Task 3: Perimeter & Area

- Find perimeter of 3 rectangles (take dimensions yourself )
- Find area & perimeter of 3 squares ( having sides 350cm, 124cm , 456cm)
- Real-life task: Measure your room and estimate its area and perimeter.
- Also find the cost of tiling your room (if it costs ₹55 per square meter)
